Ingenzi Social Enterprise Programme is a 12-week training programme implemented by Acts of Gratitude (AOG), to help youth to turn their ideas and passions into Social Enterprises



How we do this

- We provide aspiring social entrepreneurs with world-class training on social entrepreneurship, coaching, and mentorship.
- At the end of the program, a participant gets the entrepreneurial capacity to start or scale up his/her business/project and is helped to develop 5 planning and communication tools: a Business Plan, a Business Model Canvas, a Theory of Impact, a PowerPoint Presentation and a Pitch Video for their project.



Training Overview

- 5 hours a week: mandatory learning session once per week. Each Friday 9:00 am -3:00 pm
- Extra 3 hours: Optional tutoring/coaching session on every Monday-Tuesday 3-5pm to help finalize your assignment
- Breakfast and lunch are provided
